CAMP INFORMATION & POLICIES

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Registration is open until 12 pm the Friday before camp. Registration may close earlier for select camps that require special supply orders. Early registration is strongly recommended to secure your spot at camp!

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNTS

Many camps have an automatically applied early bird discount if you register on or before **February 28**. See camp pricing details to determine if your camp qualifies.

CAMP LION DAY CAMP SIBLING DISCOUNT

Families registering campers for Camp Lion, our traditional day camp experience for TK-5 grade, will automatically receive a discount on siblings who are registered at the same time.

Families will receive \$50 off half-day and \$75 off full-day registrations on all additional same family registrations after the first registration.

WAIT LISTS

For camps that are full, you may choose to be added to a wait list in the event openings become available.

LUNCH CARE (12pm - 1pm)

The Lunch Care option is for campers to bridge morning and afternoon camps or extend their camp day by an hour for a fee of **\$30/week***. Campers will be escorted to/from their camps and supervised. Lunch Care is supervision only, **campers must bring a bag lunch**.

** Special note: Camp Lion Day Camp and Musical Theater for Middle School includes Lunch Care.*

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

For campers TK-8 grade who need to be dropped off early or picked up later, Before and After Care is available. Campers are escorted to/from their camps and engaged in a variety of activities. Before Care campers may arrive between **7:30am - 8:45am**. After Care campers may be picked up between **4:00pm - 5:30pm**. **Before Care is \$50/week** and **After Care is \$50/week***.

** Special note: Camp Lion Day Camp includes Before and After Care at no additional cost, but you must indicate if you would like Before and/or After Care when you register.*

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

All campers should bring a labeled water bottle and a daily snack. Full-day campers and campers staying for lunch will also need to pack a lunch. Camp directors and the CDS Camps Office will reach out to inform registered campers/families of any additional instructions prior to camp.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP LOCATIONS

Most camps will drop-off/pick-up on the CDS campus/Warner Park fields. Your camp description will indicate if the camp takes place anywhere other than the CDS campus/Warner Park fields. The CDS Camps Office will communicate via email specific instructions for drop-off/pick-up in advance of each camp.

CANCELLATIONS, EXCHANGES & REFUNDS

In the unlikely event that CDS would need to cancel a specific camp program due to insufficient enrollment, CDS will inform parents at least 14 days prior to the camp's start date and all fees will be refunded.

Should your summer plans change, you may exchange your camp for another camp for a fee of \$20.

You may also opt to cancel your camp registration and request a refund based on the below schedule:

- Cancellations on or before May 1, 2022: *100% camp cost refunded less a \$35 processing fee*
- Cancellations after May 1, 2022 (and at least 14 days prior to your camp): *50% camp cost refunded*
- Cancellations less than 14 days prior to your camp: *Camp cost non-refundable*

- Camps will run Monday through Friday unless otherwise indicated.
- CDS summer camps are open to the community. (Invite your friends!)
- Camps are subject to change in the unlikely event of insufficient enrollment or unforeseen circumstances.

GET AUTOMATED WITH ARDUINO LINE-FOLLOWING ROBOTS

Learn how to build a robot to follow a track all by itself! The Arduino microprocessor introduces completely different challenges and allows for all kinds of enhancements from advanced speed controls to turn memory. With Arduino, unlike the basic drag-and-drop programming taught in LEGO and other robotics camps, campers will learn a programming language used in industry by real engineers. Just wait until you see your robot race along the track! It's so awesome to watch it running once you get it tuned correctly. You can even build your own track for testing and modifying your LFR at home.

This camp is great for both programming beginners and Arduino enthusiasts. Robot built during camp sold separately.

Campers are encouraged to bring their own laptop from home with the free Arduino software already installed (see www.techsplorers.com/arduino for setup instructions) but it is not required. Campers may use a camp provided laptop during camp if they do not have one.
