



Covenant Day Middle School Athletic Coach

Covenant Day School is committed to providing comprehensive sport offerings and hiring Christian head and assistant coaches to lead our middle school teams and support the mission/vision of Covenant Day School. Coaches are expected to be skilled educators and mentors in their sport and report to the Athletic Director/Assistant Athletic Director/Head Coach (depending on role). Coaching roles are seasonal, part-time positions and may be renewable on an annual basis as determined by Athletic Director.

Responsibilities and qualifications desired:

- Must be well-versed in all aspects of the sport; playing experience in high school or higher levels desired
- Knowledge of the fundamentals of coaching and experience working with middle school or high school students required
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Attend all practices and games as scheduled by the athletic director and/or head coach
- Responsible for carrying out requests of Athletic Department leadership and for partnering with other coaches and teams as needed
- Serve with the program exhibiting Christian values and testimony to encourage good sportsmanship and camaraderie
- Committed follower of Jesus Christ reflecting a desire to serve Him and others in work and life
- Eager to serve in a Christian learning environment, modeling diligence, perseverance, resilience, patience, courage, and Christian discipleship
- CPR/First Aid certified or willingness to obtain through the school
- Follow established protocol in the event of an injury to an athlete
- Physical agility to lift up to 25 pounds to shoulder height and 50 pounds to waist height
- Other duties as assigned by the varsity coach or athletic administration.

Seasonal schedule:

- Season will be as scheduled during fall, winter or spring timeframes.
- Practices are anticipated to be held between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Final schedule to be determined.
- Games will typically be played during the week. Occasional weekend games or tournaments may be scheduled. Final schedule to be determined.
